The Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village

The ultimate place to explore what Americans past and present have imagined and invented a remarkable destination that brings American ideas and innovations to life. Local Cultural Museums

- **Hitsville U.S.A.** aka The Motown Museum was headquarters to Motown Records' establishment in 1959 by Berry Gordy. It is now home to an extensive array of Motown Artifacts, photographs and other memorabilia.
- **The Charles H. Wright Museum** was founded in 1965 and holds the world's largest permanent exhibit on African American culture. The museum owns more than 35,000 artifacts and archival materials relevant to African American diaspora.
- **The Arab American National Museum** is the first and only museum in the United States devoted to Arab American history and culture. By bringing the voices and faces of Arab Americans to mainstream audiences, they continue their commitment to dispel misconceptions about Arab Americans and other minorities.
